Results of the long-term online poll:

In your opinion, which factors are most important for the integration of Armenia into Europe?

From 7 April 2009 to 10 January 2011, European Friends of Armenia posed the following question on our website (www.eufoa.org): *In your opinion, which factors are most important for the integration of Armenia into Europe?*

The intention of this long-term online poll was to find out what visitors to our website think about this very broad subject. Given the time span of one and three quarter years, as well as the specific profile of visitors frequenting our website (they have already expressed an interest in Armenian-European relations), we are aware that the poll is not representative. Rather, the poll gives an insight into the factors people already interested in this field consider most important for Armenian integration into Europe.
